Move-ups will be added to the end of the running order of the class they move up to. Every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class. **FOOD:** Food is not available on the show site for exhibitors at these trials. There are restaurants within walking distance or nearby and a deli in Knowlan's Grocery.

**CRATING SPACE:** Limited with no expens being allowed. Crate in designated areas only. No crating is allowed in the back hallway behind the men's restroom.

**WARM-UPS:** A warm-up area in lunchroom-crating area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for all exhibitors.

**OBSTACLES:** Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

**DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER:** As it states in the Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 3, All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate except bitches in heat, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Dogs or registerable breeds with accepted foreign registration numbers are eligible to participate.

**HEIGHT DIVISIONS:** Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All measurements are at the dog's withers.

**Regular classes**

Dogs MAY enter a higher jump height.  
8 inches: 11" or less at the withers  
12 inches: 11.12 inches - 14" at the withers  
16 inches: 14.12" - 18" at the withers  
20 inches: 18.12 - 22" at the withers  
24 inches - More than 22" at the withers  
26 inches - May be entered at owner's discretion

**Preferred Classes**

Dogs MAY NOT enter a higher jump height  
4 inches: 11" & under at the withers  
8 inches: 11.12 inches - 14" at the withers  
12 inches: 14.12" - 18" at the withers  
16 inches: 18.12 - 22" at the withers  
20 inches - More than 22" at the withers

**REFUNDS:** Entry fees for bitches that come into season and injured dogs after the closing date will be refunded (minus a \$15.00 administrative fee per day) if a veterinarian certificate is presented to the trial secretary prior to the start of judging. Refunds will not be given for refund amounts of \$ 5 or less. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by vet or judge, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee.

**PRIZE AND AWARDS:** Flat ribbons will be awarded for the 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place dogs in each STD and JWW class. A green qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score. "New Title" Rosettes will be available for qualifying teams. A MACH/PACH bar and Rosette will be awarded to each team earning a MACH/PACH. The club reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value. All awards and prizes must be claimed at the show as none will be mailed.

- 1st Prize: Blue
- 2nd Place: Red
- 3rd Place: Yellow
- 4th Place: White

Qualifying Ribbon: Dark Green



**RINGSIDE:** Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your run, and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run.

**SAFETY/BEHAVIOR:** The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. **All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area.**

**LIABILITY:** It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Twin Cities Voyageur English Springer Spaniel Association and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

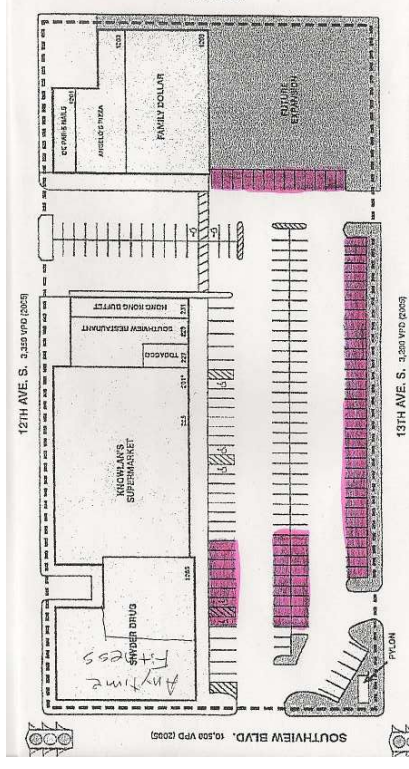
St. Paul Dog Training Club is located to the left of Knowlan's Grocery - look for sign on door

### INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners<sup>SM</sup> program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
