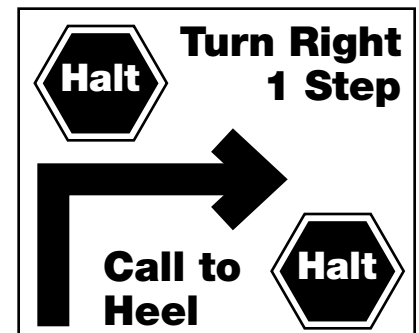
Fun at Rally Day

Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Jon Pidde reported a balance of \$7,349.88 in the club's checking account.

The reading of the meeting's minutes was waived.

Membership update- We had 8 late membership renewals. There were 7 members that didn't renew from last year.

Julie Wilson will update the club's website with current membership application and this year's board members. We need to ask if she can update the site with this year's show dates and the cardiac/eye/microchip clinic information.

9/24- WD test at Major Avenue Hunt Club, Glencoe, MN. Bill Dunaski will be our judge. The board set the entry fee for WD test at \$35.

9/30 and 10/1- tracking seminar- Kristin Radermacher is in charge of this. She is still trying to find a location for the seminar.

There was a suggestion to create an "Upcoming Events" page for the VOX.

CERF/Cardiac/Microchip clinic on 8/27/06- Kris has asked for the appropriate forms in advance of the clinic from each doctor. We discussed the possibility of doing a blood draw for the DNA project in conjunction with the other health screenings at the clinic. We decided to do a blood draw at the match instead of at the all-breed shows since it's specifically related to ESS.

2006 Specialty

- Reserved grooming set up- Ann Sunderman may not be able to be at the show site to do it. The board was made aware of this fact now so planning could be done for someone else to mark off the grooming spaces.
- Prize drawings at specialty- Kris has sent e-mails to over 400 companies for donations. She isn't asking club members for donations because she has so many things already.
- Barb Ciresi and Maryevelyn Monty will be doing the after-show hospitality at the specialty.
- Kris Radermacher will try for the donated bagels for the specialty again.
- The board voted to give a framed print (one of the ones the club had donated to it) to Tom Alexander for judging. He's not charging us a fee. The club will ship it home for him if he can't take it with him.

Prints – The club still has several of the donated springer prints. We could possibly give one away at our match or at the WD test. We decided not to have one at the specialty because there will be too many other items to be given away.

Education committee – Dr. Root Kustritz has availability for Jan/Feb. 2008 to present a canine reproduction seminar. We discussed hosting this the weekend following the Land O' Lakes shows in January. The Education Committee is trying to book Patricia McConnell for a canine behavior seminar in 2007. Kristin Radermacher had asked the board's opinion on hosting a seminar by either George Alston or Pat Hastings. The club has hosted seminars by both of these presenters in the past and feels someone else would be a better draw.

Nationals – Kristin Radermacher reported the ESSFTA 2010 national specialty show is in Oregon. Any future considerations for a TCVESSA hosted national will have to be for 2011 or beyond.
