- 1. No professional portraits, unless I get written permission from the photographer to do so.
- 2. No "win" shots, please. I'd like to keep it informal and fun and not look like advertising.
- 3. Pictures of your dogs "working" would be wonderful gaiting in the ring counts as working; it's what they were bred to do.
- 4. They must be digital files, I can resize them if necessary but I'm doing this for free so they must otherwise be ready to upload to the site. If possible size them at 800px on the longest side at 72dpi. Landscape (wider across than tall) orientation works best, I can work with a portrait orientation but I will have to crop, and can't guarantee what I'll have to crop out.
- 5. Please include the owner's full name (for my files only), the dog's call name and a caption if you'd like that instead of just the call name.
- 6. Right now there is no limit on the number of pictures. If I get inundated with pictures and we don't have enough space on the site I may have to limit the number. I'll advise everyone if I need to do that.
