BOARD MEETING MINUTES TCVESSA BOARD MEETING August 17, 2017 President Liz Pike called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. Members Present: Liz Pike, Kathy Patregnani, Courtney Hansen, Diane Slais, Julie Roberts, Tekla Viker, Carmen Laing and Alice Musburger. Officers Absent: B.A. Breese. Approval of Minutes from July 3, 2017. Kathy moved to approve the minutes and Courtney gave a second. The motion passed. Treasurers Report: \$3,078.53. Expenses since occurred were mesh ringside bags purchased by Courtney and Rubber Maid containers purchased by Kathy. Old Business: The annual Fall General Membership Meeting was discussed. The date was set to be Sunday afternoon, November 12, 2017. Locations were mentioned. Fusion with Mike Teh was too expensive unless owner agreed to a lower price. Kathy and Diane are to check with Dawn on Cloud 9 Minnetonka location and requirements. Kathy volunteered to also check with Sue Kothe on using Total Recall as was done last year.

Discussion continued on holding our Spring Specialty with the Cavalier Club as a joint specialty. Many pros and cons were brought forth. It was noted that the Cavalier Club would not tax obedience or rally entries and judges much as they would have a very small entry. TCVESSA would save \$1,000 if the two-day building rental were split. It would be very difficult to find breed judges who could justly judge Springers from the sporting group as well as judge Cavaliers from the toy group. Other ways cut the club's costs were explored but nothing concrete was decided. A difference in the personality of the two clubs' was compared. It was noted by many that we have worked hard for several years to create the special atmosphere our specialty is noted for. The final decision on entertaining a joint specialty was tabled until the September meeting in order to give everyone more time to fully consider this idea.

The search for conformation judges for the 2018 Specialty is ongoing. Judges from the Bismarck Shows this summer were mentioned as well as Eva Berg, Patricia Trotter, Lorrraine Botwell and Charles Olvis. It was agreed to find years in advance that Linda Robe and Steve Danaird could be contracted. Local judges such as Penny Freeburg and Susie Bossard could cut costs. Contacting Dr. Dana Massey Smith again is a possibility. More discussion will follow.

New Business: It was decided that TCVESSA would not participate this year in agility demonstrations at the Minnesota State Fair. The club has volunteered for the past two years. It is a long day and a lot of work and nothing benefitted the club in terms of new members or even inquiries about our club or breed. The club would also not be participating in the Minnesota Responsible Dog Ownership Day on September 9th by the St. Croix Valley KC.

Liz brought up that according to the by-laws it is time to appoint the nominating committee for the board for the year 2018. Courtney is willing to be the board representative along with two at large members from the club. Karen Anderson and Janice Johnson are going to be asked. The by

Topics were tick borne diseases, canine epilepsy and drug effectiveness, fertility versus sperm motility and morphology as well as pyometria and drugs used with bitches going into season and more. It was a wonderful conference.

Carmen mentioned that the annual awards banquet for 2018 would fall on St. Patrick's Day. She will look into changing our date with the Roasted Pear to either March 10th or 24th to avoid the St. Pat's crowd.

Motion was moved and carried to adjourn.

Next meeting is scheduled to be Thursday, September 28, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. via conference call.
